





"...NOT THAT"

t the beginning of Lent, I was diagnosed with a condition that has forced me to completely alter my diet, giving up almost all grains, starches and sugar. It's really hard: a roller-coaster ride of emotions, a complication in every outing and especially in travel. But it's also a spiritual opportunity to detach.

I'm a great one for ambitious Lenten resolutions, which gradually fall apart. It was quite different to actually give something up and stick to it, especially since I couldn't feast on those things when Easter came. This condition takes two years to cure, so I am thinking of this as a novitiate into a deeper relationship with God. I have no choice but to turn to God for strength in the face of discouragement. I am also learning not to look too far ahead (two years?!) and to take one day at a time. Panic happens whenever I project into the future with anything, so this is a good training ground for my will – controlling the fear of my own inadequacy.

Perseverance is the key for so many things. Even though I blow it every day, I know God can accomplish great things if I just keep moving forward in trust. I have tried to teach this to my kids, and I hope they have the courage to stand firm, especially in their faith, which will face so many challenges and persecutions.



I ask God for courage to do His Will, and to continue to strive for holiness in the little sacrifices of daily life.

EXTRAORDINARY EVIL. EXTRAORDINARY GRACE..."

Why is Divine Mercy so relevant right now in our culture?

Our culture is going to pot. Literally!

I just finished giving a talk in Colorado, and that state, along with others, had recently legalized pot. That, for me, was yet another sign of the downward slide of our culture. People may say, "Oh, it's just pot." But that's the thing: We already live in a culture of addiction and bondage to substances and sin. The last thing we need is more drugs!

So many of us are stressed out, anxious, frightened, and depressed. The suicide rate is higher than ever. In some ways, we're living in a time of unprecedented evil. The good news is that God is not outdone by evil, and that in a time of extraordinary evil, God offers extraordinary grace. (See Rom 5:20.) This good news is the message of Divine Mercy. God wants to tell us, "Be not afraid! My mercy is more powerful than

evil. Turn to me. Trust in me. I long to give you a peace that the world cannot give."

Were you surprised when Leonardo contacted you about FAUSTINA: MESSENGER OF DIVINE MERCY?

Yes. When he called, I thought to myself, "It's the voice of Jesus from the Gospel of John CD. Jesus is calling me!" In all seriousness, that actually is how it felt when I spoke with Leonardo, but for a different reason. Even before he finished explaining the project, it seemed completely clear to me that it's something the Lord desires — and it's a perfect fit.


Why do you think the Faustina production will be so powerful?

People say they know that the mercy of God is infinite, but in their hearts, they're still convinced that they're too bad for such mercy, that they've committed too many sins. A live drama presentation can become an encounter that breaks open our hearts to let in the tender mercy of God. It has the power to convince us, each one of us individually, on a deeper level, "Jesus loves me" — period. What

will it be like to see Jesus and Faustina on stage as real, living people. What will it be like to be in the same room with them as they look at us and speak to us? I can hardly wait to find out.
